

PROCESS

01: Secure your date

To secure your date in our diary we ask for a £250 holding deposit, which will be used towards your final spend.

02: Meet with us

We set up a virtual meeting to get to know you both a little and chat through all your ideas.

03: We make a moodboard

Based on the vibe you want to create, we make a bespoke mood board of ideas for you to look through. Please note that a mood board is just that and will be used for inspiration only - we are unable to exactly copy any one design.

04: You select your designs

You tell us what you'd like from your mood board and we send you over a quote. If you're happy we'll transfer that into an invoice. Please note that decisions have to be made within two weeks of your quote being issued, otherwise the invoice total isn't guaranteed.

05: Payment made

Once you have decided on your items 50% of your overall spend is due, with the remaining balance due one month before the big day.









COLLECTION FLOWERS

01 PICK YOUR PACKAGE

You can pick and mix from the options on the right - choosing the right flowers for you and your celebration.

02 ORDER VIA EMAIL

Once you've chosen which flowers you'd like, send us an email through this form, and we'll send you back an invoice to secure your date.

ORGANISE PAYMENT

Full payment details will be on your invoice. Once we have received your payment your date is secured in our calendar.

04 COLLECT ON THE DAY

We'll have everything packaged uo ready for you to collect simply tell us what time suits and we will arrange the rest.

RETURN ANY PROPS

After the party is over, head back to us with any boxes, crates and props, and you're done.

FAQS PT. 1



How far ahead can we book? We take bookings a maximum of one year in advance.

Is there a minimum spend? Yes, our minimum spend is

£2000 for flowers.

Do you source specific flowers?

We try where possible to use seasonal, British flowers and are at the mercy of mother nature but we will always try our best if you have something that you'd love to have.

Can we change our order?

We allow couples to make changes to their invoice up to one month before their wedding. Changes cannot take the overall spend lower than the original figure, but additions can be made.

Can you do a turn around?

Yes, we're happy to do a turn around service. This is charged at £50 per person, per hour and is needed if your ceremony and reception are in the same room.

Can we come and see you at your studio?

Unfortunately we're not set-up as a showroom and don't have a space to meet couples in person. We've found online video chats to be a wonderful world though, and are always on the other end of an email if you need us.

Can you do a site visit at our venue?

Yes, if we haven't worked at your venue previously we'd love to see it in person. Site visits are charged at £150 plus mileage and are mainly needed if you'd like an installation piece.

Where do you cover?

If you'll have us, we'll travel anywhere. We're based in Helensburgh and charge mileage at 50p per mile from our studio. If you venue is more than two hours away we also charge for overnight accommodation and are happy to work internationally.



FAQS PT. 2



How sustainable is the business?

We try - where possible - to source our flowers from smallscale British suppliers. We do add to these with imported flowers but the more flexible you can be, the greater percentage of local flowers we can source for you.

We never use floral foam, which many event florists use, as it breaks down into micro-plastics which end up in our oceans.

We also compost all our green waste, instead of sending it to landfill.

Each year we try to improve on the one that's gone before, and welcome suggestions or questions about what we can do to make your celebration a little lighter on the planet.

How inclusive are you?

We know no two weddings are the same (that would be very boring, frankly) and are proud to work with couples of any sexual orientation, gender identity, faith or race.

What happens to our flowers after our wedding?

You are of course free to keep any florals you would like after your wedding day, but all blooms must be removed from their vessels, as we come back to collect these the next day.

Please bear in mind that wedding florals are perfectly timed to be at their peak for your special day - at their most open. This means that they often fade quickly after their performance, especially if left in a hot venue over night.

Can you help us find other suppliers?

We're very lucky to work with amazing wedding suppliers all over Scotland. If you haven't yet secured all your vendors and would like suggestions, please do let us know. And if you like any of the pictures included in this info pack we can point you in the direction of who snapped them.





















T&Cs

These are really important. Please take the time to read our terms and conditions in their entirety before you decide to book, as these are legally binding. You can find them on our website or in our email signature. Here are a few to give you an idea of what to expect.

All deposits are non-refundable and nontransferable.

If the event is canceled for any reason, the client agrees to full responsibility of any remaining balance due to Lavender and Rose Ltd.

We have the right to make last minute changes if necessary without consultation.

After the initial invoice has been issued clients will be allowed to make two rounds of changes, with a maximum of three invoices in total being issued to any one client. Changes must not cause the total value of the original invoice to decrease.

Upon collection, if any vessels or props are missing, the client agrees to be billed for replacement.

Lavender and Rose Ltd has a no-tolerance bullying policy. Everyone on the Lavender and Rose Ltd team will be treated with respect by our clients at all times, before, during, and after your event.
